2 LICENSING HEARING

Background:

Two applications have been received in respect of Hook Norton Sports & Social Club, The Playing Fields, The Bourne, Hook Norton, Banbury that is to be considered by the Committee. The applications are for the grant of a new club premises certificate and the grant of a new premises licence to be issued under the Licensing Act 2003. Details are provided in the attached report.
