<p>During a search of BANBURY EXPRESS FOOD &amp; WINE, 179 Warwick Road, Banbury, OX16 1AS for illicit tobacco on 09/06/19 a quantity of nitrous oxide (NO2) cannisters were discovered in the rear store room. Whilst these have a legitimate use in whipped cream guns or drinks infusers they are more commonly sold as a "legal high" and are prohibited from sale for this purpose under the Psychoactive Substances Act 2016. Five boxes each containing 24x8g cannisters were found in the store room. They were in their original packaging box that would have held approx 25 of these boxes (5 rows of 5) - the packaging on the outer box and all the individual smaller boxes all indicate that their sale for inhalation is an offence &amp; potentially harmful. The brand name appears to be "INSTANT INFUSION" but also has the company names "MOSA" and "BESTWHIP" on them. No company address but indicated that they were produced in Taiwan. Two web addresses given: WWW.INSTANTINFUSIONS.COM and WWW.GICREAM.COM. See attached photos for further details.</p> <p>During the search in the glass display case immediately inside the door of the store (also used to display a selection of cannabis grinders, water pipes and other smoking paraphernalia) a quantity of finger or micro-mobile phones were on display. These are commonly known as "HMP" or "BEAT THE BOSS" phones and are frequently smuggled into prisons. Several different types on display including the V-2 and the 3in1 J8 World Smallest Mobile Phone. Photos of the phones on display are attached.</p> <p>One of the smaller store rooms at the side of the shop also appears to be in use as a bedroom. There was a mattress and blanket on the floor, a new mattress (still in the packaging) against the wall and a quantity of bedding/clothing at the rear of the storeroom. The staff WC also had toiletries and cosmetics (toothbrushes, deoderant etc) that had been used in a cabinet under the sink. There was a quantity of stock (coffee, vodka &amp; infant formula) on top of the mattresses but these were all kept in baskets/bags so they could be removed easily.</p>					1	A	P
