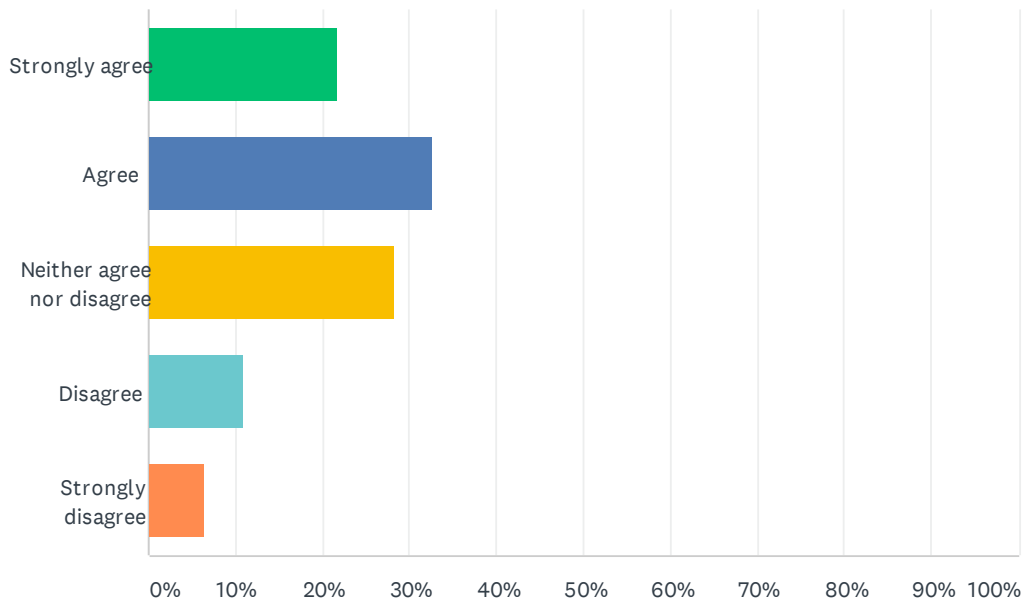

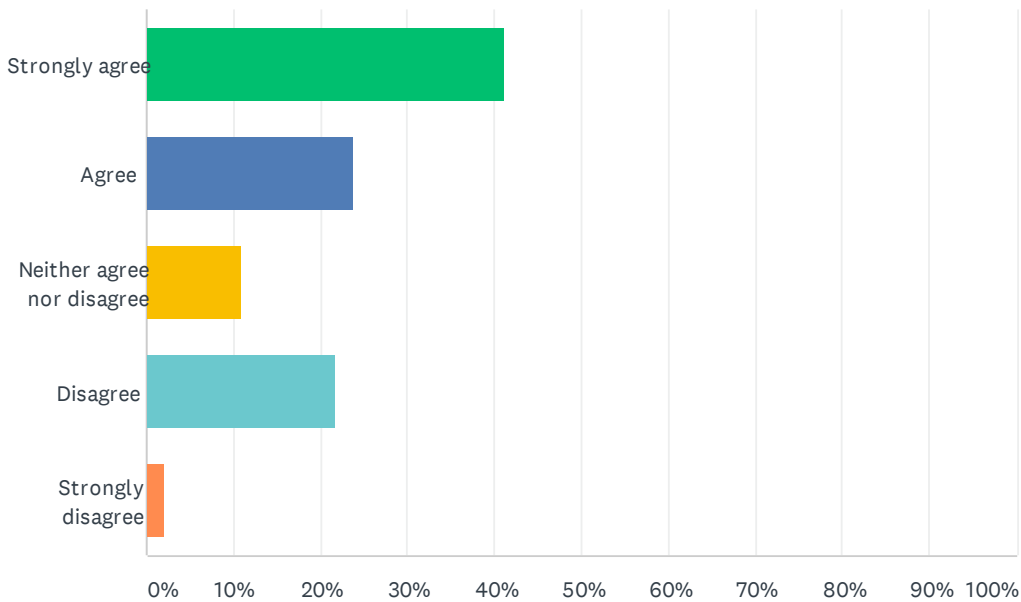

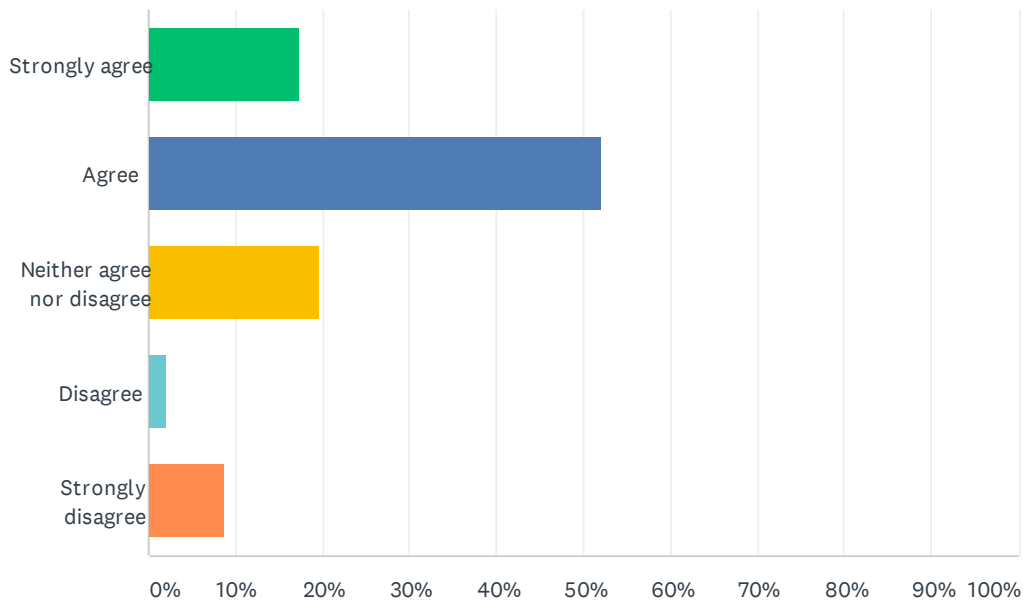

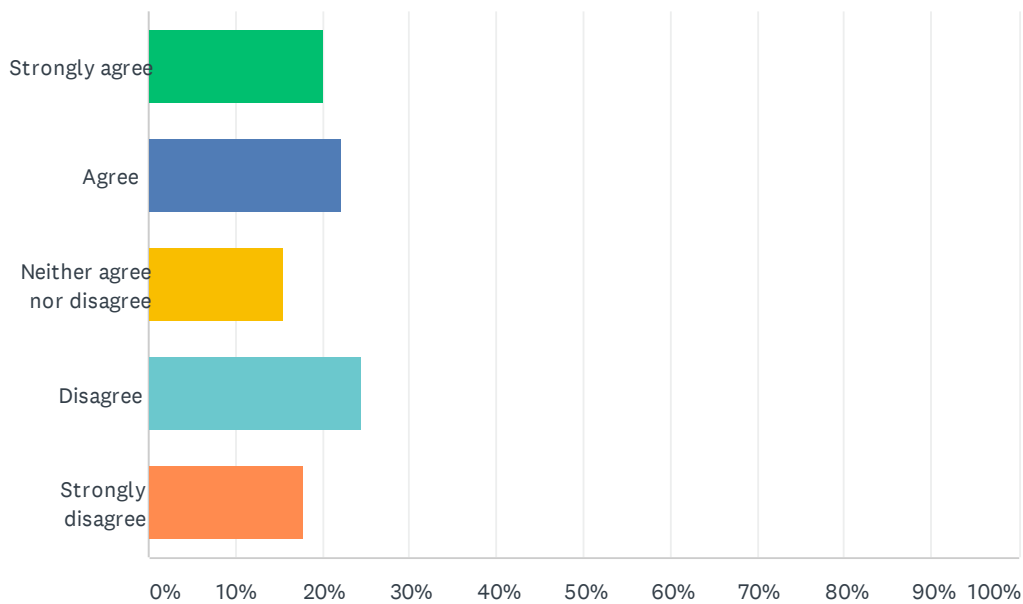

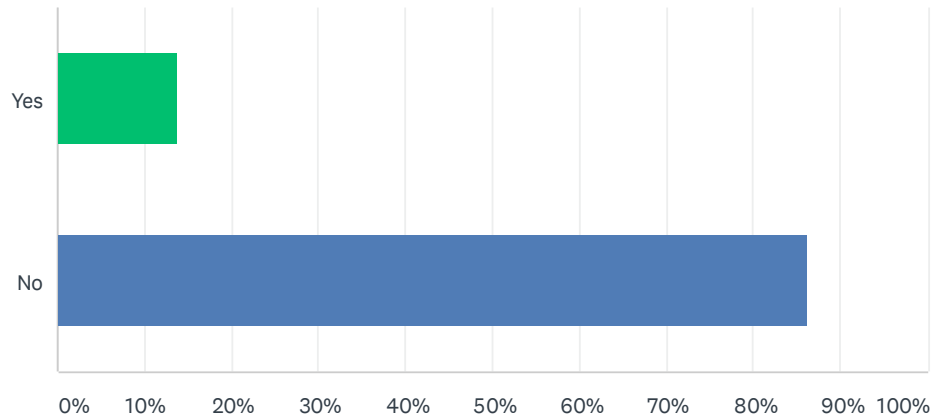

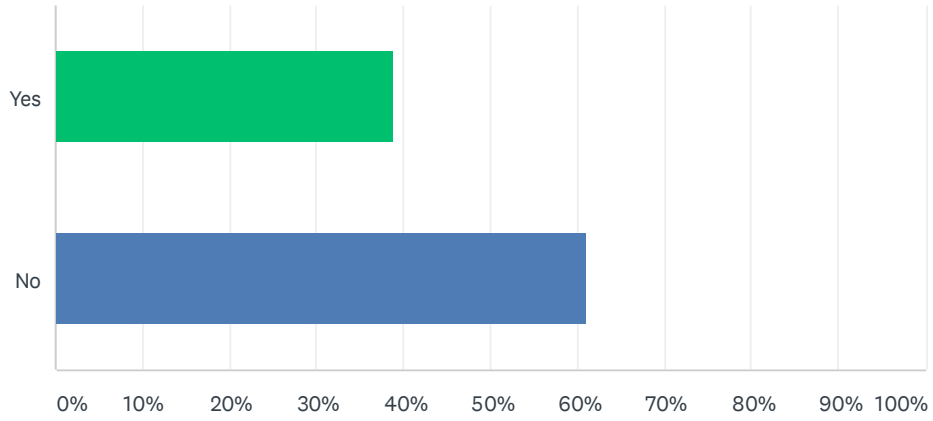

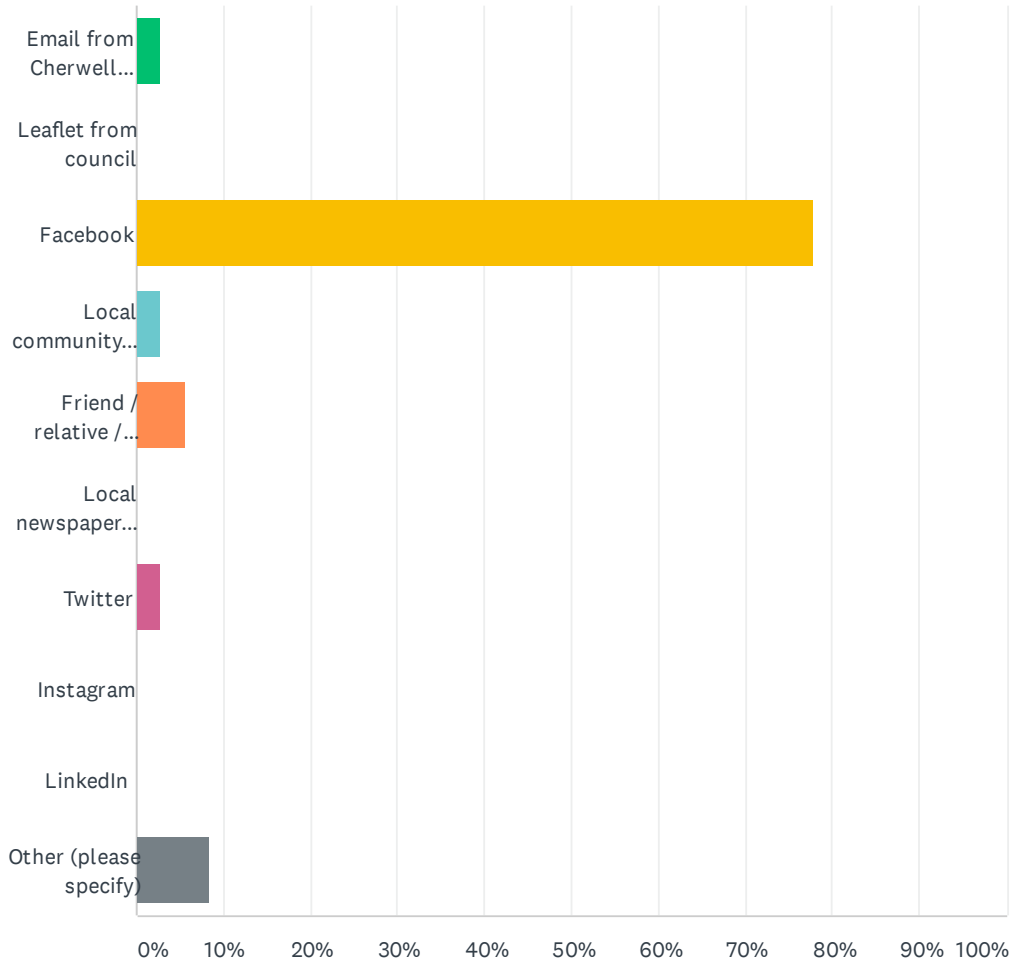

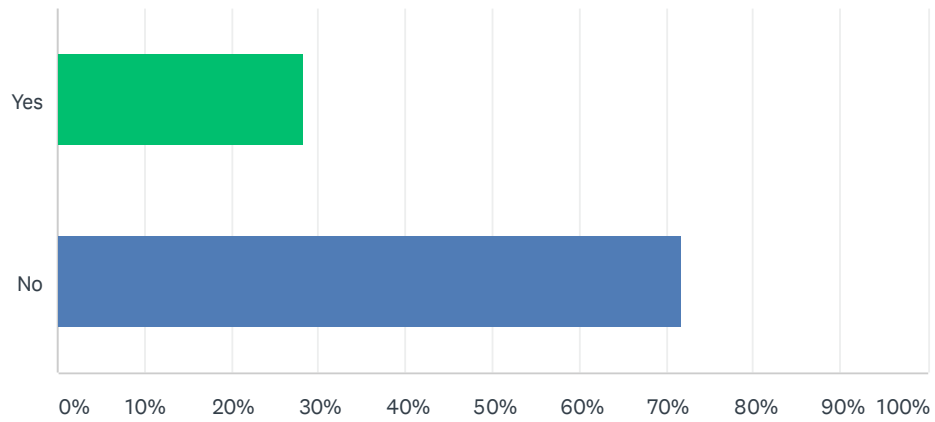

## Q9 Have you made an application to join the housing register within the last 3 years?

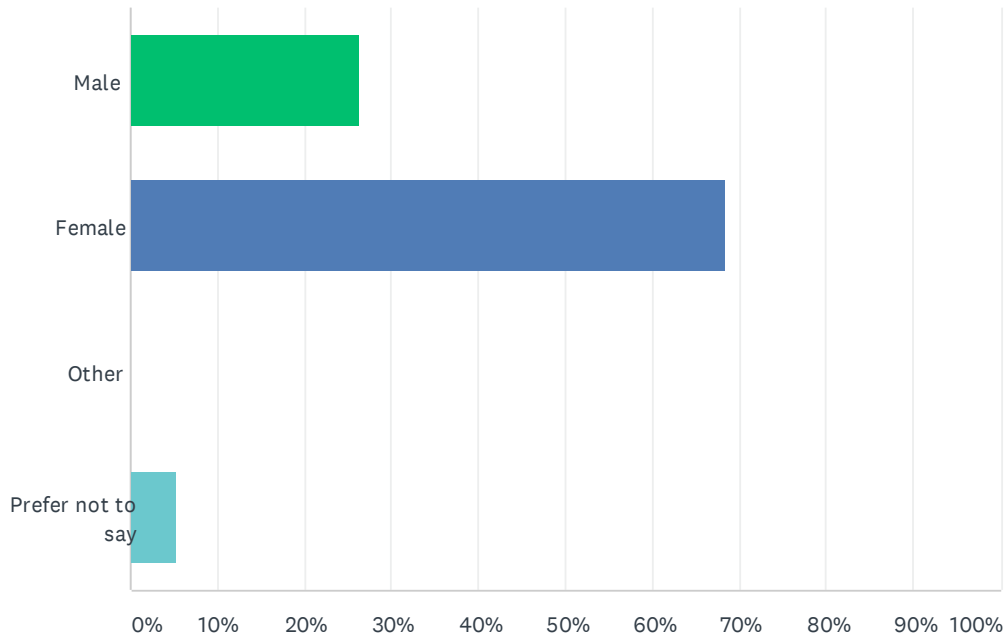

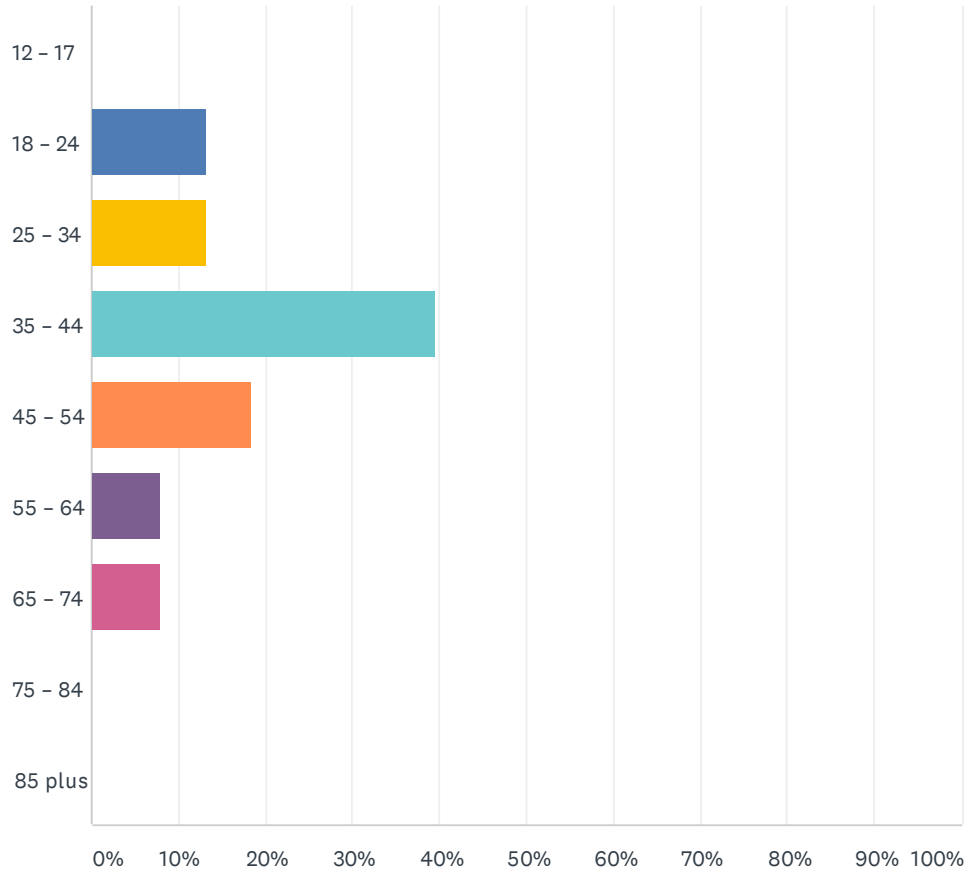

## Q11 What is your age group?

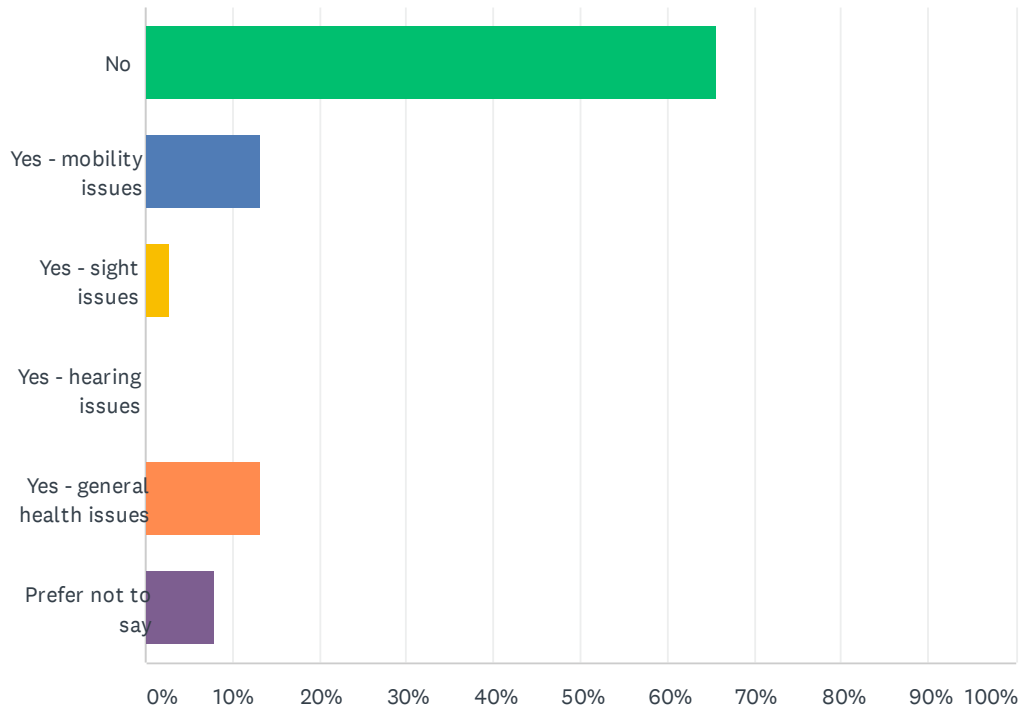

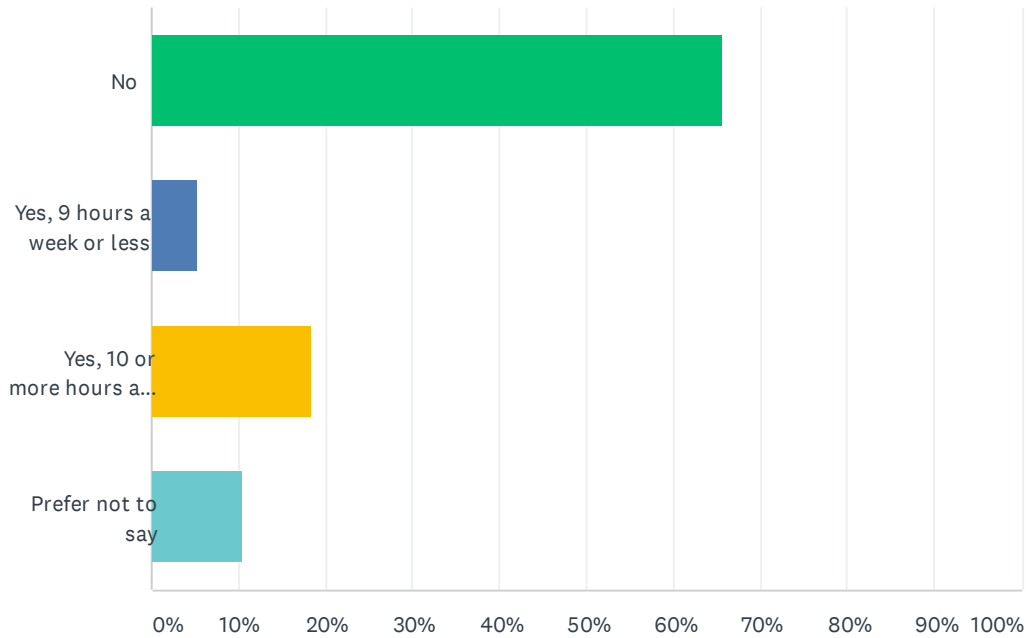

### Q13 Do you look after, or give any help or support to anyone because they have long-term physical or mental health conditions or illnesses, or problems related to old age?

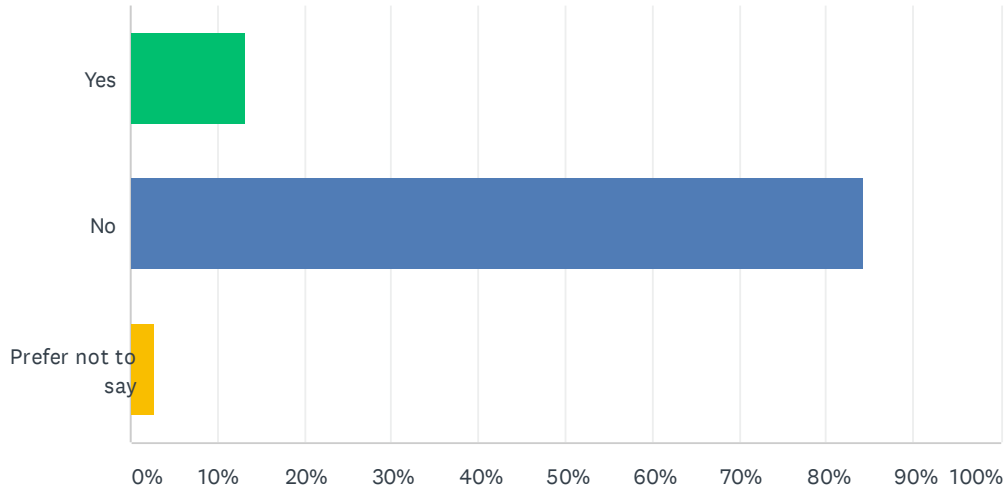

## Q14 Are you currently pregnant or have you been pregnant in the last year?

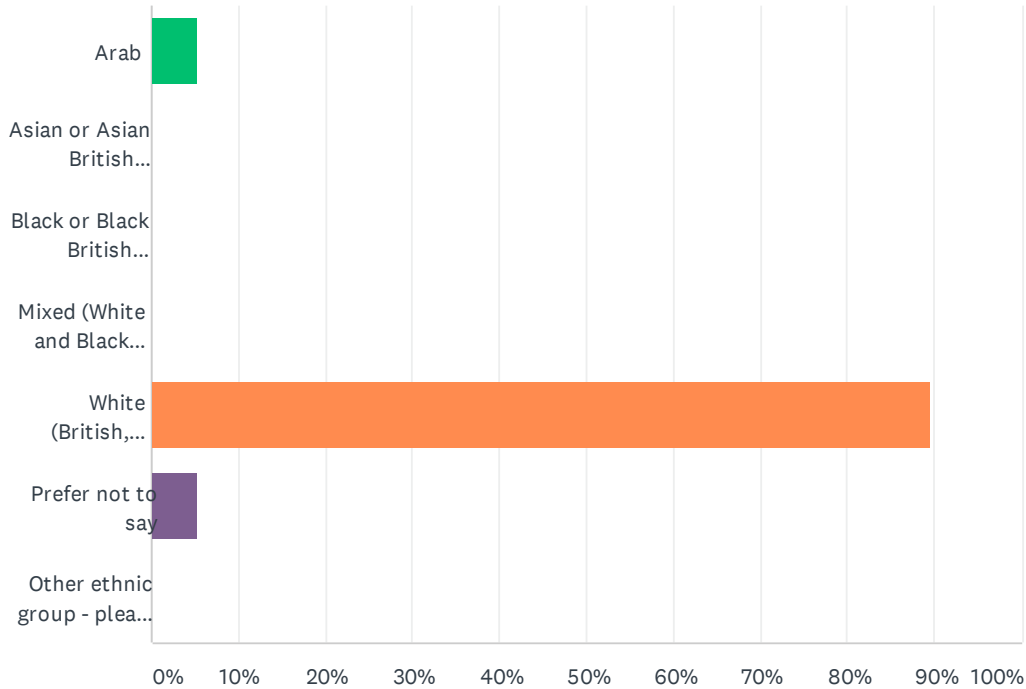
