Licensing Act 2003 – Grant of Premises Licence Application
The Indian Pantry, 65 Calthorpe Street, Banbury.

I refer to the hearing of the Licensing Sub-Committee on 20 August 2010 at which the Sub-Committee considered an application in respect of the above premises for the variation grant of a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003. The decision contained in this letter is a decision of the Licensing Authority.

After considering all the representations made at the hearing the Sub-Committee decided as follows:

'Having listened to the representations made by all interested parties and considered them against the four licensing objectives, the Sub-Committee approves the application for the grant of a premises licence in relation to 'The Indian Pantry' in Calthorpe Street, Banbury for the hours applied for, namely:

- **11:00pm to 1:00am the following morning on a Thursday,**
- **11:00pm to 2:00am the following morning on a Friday and Saturday, and**
- **11:00pm to midnight on a Sunday.**

The conditions proposed by the applicant at page 3 of the agenda were accepted and imposed on the licence.'
