**Agenda Item 7**      **08/01897/CM Ashgrove Farm, Middleton Stoney Rd. Ardley**

The Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Manger has expressed concern about the quality of the noise information supplied by the applicant.. He considers that the information does not allow a robust decision to be made about noise impact. Working with the data provided an adverse noise impact seems to be unlikely but due to the shortcomings of the document it is not possible to be authoritative. He has recommended that although the County Council could use an LAmax limit condition it would be a speculative approach due to the absence of data.

It is **RECOMMENDED** that these comments are relayed to the County Council as determining authority.

**Agenda Item 8**      **08/01942/F Campsfield House, Langford Lane, Kidlington.**

1. Oxfordshire County Council as highway authority raise no objections to the proposal as they consider that the proposal will not generate a significant amount of new trips to and from the site.
2. Oxford Airport request that the new buildings are no higher than the existing buildings. This is because the Airport has an aspiration of gaining radar in the future. Although there are higher trees around if radar was acquired these may become the subject of safeguarding with a reduction in height required
