Sorry for writing so late, but I'll try to give you all the informations that you need.

Since they've started at the beginning of February, they started very loud. Since then I can't see much improvement. There is always a problem with loud music at the end of the week, but the worst is alway Saturday, when they've a disco night. At the beginning of April situation got bit better, but that was only for a while. Now is almost the same level of noise as was in February.

At my flat I can always hear the music, even if it's not so loud. The worst place in my flat is bedroom and by the entrance door, where you can hear everything very clearly, including words of the song. Sometimes I can even hear people talking downstairs.

On Saturdays, when they have a lot of customers, is the worst. Now the basses are lower, but at the beginning was hard to stand that noise at home. It's still too loud, as I can hear the music like it would be in my place. I can feel basses on the floor everytime when they're playing music.

They starts always around 9 p.m. and finishes about 12-1 a.m., but sometimes it lasts till 2 a.m. They starting ath Thursdays with not very loud music, on Friday is getting worse, as they plays little louder. On Saturdays is the worst day, as they are very loud and are open till late (1-2 a.m.). On Sundays they have "live music", and this is not very quiet, either.

I can't say if ther is a big problem with a smoke, because I always close the window when it's too loud, just to minimise the noise level at home as much as I can.
