PN29 The premises shall have a written dispersal procedure designed to make the maximum contribution immediately before the premises close, and directly thereafter, by exercising pro-active measures, to move customers from the premises and the immediate vicinity in such a way as to cause minimum disturbance or nuisance to residential neighbours and to make the minimum impact upon the neighbourhood in relation to potential nuisance, antisocial behaviour, crime and disorder.

PN40 After close of business a rubbish patrol should pick up any flyers or rubbish associated with smokers, which may have been left by customers in the immediate vicinity of the premises.

These conditions are to ensure minimum disturbance to the local residents that are in close proximity to the premises. If these recommendations are followed then I can confirm that Safer Communities & Community Development would not object to the licensable activities as set out in **Mr Jack Andreas Michael's** license application dated **3rd June 2008**
