Purpose of report

This report provides an update to the Council's Revenue and Capital position for the first nine months of the financial year 2016-17 and projections for the full year as requested at the meeting of this Committee on 28 February 2017.

1.0 Recommendations

Budget Planning Committee is recommended:

1.1 To review the update to the projected revenue and capital position at the end of December 2016, which provides additional information relating to significant revenue variances and slippage against the capital programme, and make any comments to Executive.

2.0 Introduction

2.1 The Council's revenue and capital position to the end of December 2016 was reported to the Budget Planning Committee at its meeting on 28 February 2017. Further information relating to significant variances on revenue budgets and slippage on the capital programme was requested by the committee.

3.0 Report Details

Projected Revenue Outturn 2016-17

3.1 Further information was requested in relation to significant variances against revenue budgets, this information is presented at Appendix 1. This appendix will follow as it is being finalised as at the date of the publication of this report.

Projected Capital Outturn 2016-17

- 3.2 The committee requested additional information relating to projected slippage against the capital programme which mainly relates to the following schemes:
 - £2.5m for the NW Bicester Eco Business Centre where a procurement exercise is underway and it is anticipated that the majority of spend will occur in 2017/18.
 - £0.15m for the North Oxfordshire Academy Astroturf project which is delayed.
 - £0.15m for the Bicester Leisure Centre Extension where feasibility studies have just commenced.
 - £0.181m for Wheeled Bin Replacement where delivery has been delayed.
