## Annex to Minutes - Proportionality Calculations

1.1 Under the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990 made pursuant to the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, allocations of committee seats are made to political groups and any member not in a political group is consequently not automatically entitled to seats on committees. 1.3 The Constitution sets out that the Planning Committee has 12 named substitutes. - Green and Independent Alliance Group - 1
- Independent Group - 1
1.4 Political Groups must have regard to the following when nominating Committee members:
- Overview and Scrutiny Committee must not include any members of the Executive
- Personnel Committee members must include at least one member of the Executive and may not include members of the Appeals Panel
- Appeals Panel members may not serve as members of the Personnel Committee
